# May 2014 Turner's Meeting – Making rolling pins with Celtic knots.

David Smith showed us the jigs he uses to make rolling pins with an embedded Celtic knot motif. He uses a custom made angle cutting jig on a table saw to make the angled cuts. The depth of cut is carefully selected to ensure that the pieces are not quite cut in half so that the alignment is kept between cuts. Each cut is inlaid with a contrasting wood and glued up, before the next cut is made. Once all the cuts are made, the blank is turned. David uses the French double tapered rolling pin design which is most effective for rolling pastry in his experience. The process is documented here: www.lumberjocks.com/lew/blog/6086



**Bobby's chair.** Based on a 15<sup>th</sup> century design documented in Practical Woodworking, who called it Breugel's chair. Bobby used African Rosewood.

**Homework for June** – turn a lidded box of any design.

Wood of the Month: Fagus Sylvatica – European Beech. A stable hardwood with a characteristic grain fleck that makes it easily recognisable. European Beech is stable in drying, easily worked and readily available, it is widely used for furniture and tools such wooden planes, tool handles, biscuits, and dowels. Light coloured and steamed (pink) varieties are available in substantial sizes as the trees can grow to 50m in height with trunks up to 3m in diameter.

May 2014 Meeting – Greg De Villiers from Vermont tools demonstrated the Kreg pocket hole and doweling jigs. ▶





Greg also showed a range of spring tools that have a range of uses in marking and driving small nails.
